



Weekly Commentary

- U.S. markets ended the week mixed as investors digested earnings from several of the world's largest companies. DJIA jumped 0.5%, the S&P gained 0.2% and the NASDAQ increased 1.1% last week.

- In energy news, crude oil futures fell 4.7%, closing the week at \$53.90 per barrel on speculation that the OPEC will agree to cut levels of production. Natural gas fell 5.6% to close the week at \$2.75 per mmbtu as the Energy Information Administration reported an increase in inventories of 64 billion cubic feet to 3.710 trillion cubic feet for the week ended October 20. Analysts were expecting an increase of 66 billion cubic feet.

- In U.S. economic news, Q3 GDP-adv. came in at 3.0%, slightly below the prior reading of 3.1%, but higher than estimates of 2.4% growth. Additionally, the Q3 GDP deflator came in at 2.2%, following the prior reading of 1.0% and estimates of 1.8%. Separately, Advanced International Trade in Goods for September reported a \$64.1 billion deficit, above the \$63.3 billion deficit in the prior month. Advanced Wholesale Inventories for the same month increased 0.3%, falling from the prior month's downwardly-revised gain of 0.8%. In the housing news, the MBA Mortgage Applications Index fell 4.6% for the week ended and reversing course from the 3.6% increase in the prior week. In addition, new home sales for the month of September tallied 667K, above estimates of 555K, and rising from the upwardly-revised 561K posted in the prior month. Pending home sales reported a no change, above the downwardly-revised 2.8% decrease in the prior month. In the labor market, initial claims for the week ended were reported as 233K, above the prior week's upwardly-revised 223K, and falling below consensus estimates of 235K.

- In corporate news, Caterpillar Inc., General Motors Company, Las Vegas Sands Corp., and Gilead Sciences, Inc. beat analysts' earnings estimates, while Whirlpool Corporation, Chipotle Mexican Grill, Inc., and Dr. Pepper Snapple Group, Inc. fell short. United Parcel Services, Inc. and Bristol-Myers Squibb Company reported mixed earnings. In M&A news, Apple Inc. acquired New Zealand's PowerbyProxi for an undisclosed amount.

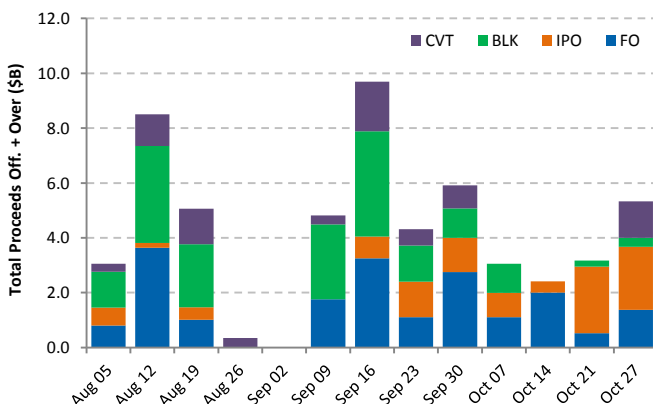

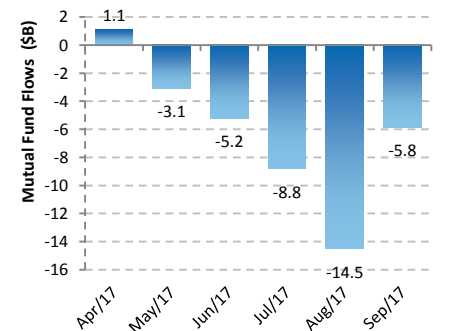
Trailing U.S. New Issuance by Deal Type

Priced Deals

Week Ending October 27, 2017

New Issuance Recap:

As the World Series got underway between the L.A. Dodgers and Houston Astros, the new issuance market had an exciting week, welcoming 23 deals (7 IPOs, 12 FOs, 2 BLKs, and 2 CVTs) for aggregate proceeds of \$5.3B. Specifically, the IPO market raised the most proceeds of any offering type as seven companies made their debut for a total of \$2.3B in proceeds. Leading the way, in terms of proceeds, were BP Midstream Partners (\$765.0), Nexa Resources S.A. (\$496.0M), National Vision Holdings, Inc. (\$347.6M), and Haymaker Acquisition Corp. (\$300.0M). Notably, these four deals mark the first time since the week of September 29–October 3 in 2014 that four IPOs have come to market each for \$300.0M or more. Turning to follow-ons during the week, the largest offering debuted out of Hong Kong, coming from the Healthcare sector, as Hutchison China MediTech Ltd. raised \$301.3M. Meanwhile, Camping World Holdings, Inc. and Ablynx NV priced their offerings to bring in \$271.4M and \$230.0M in proceeds, respectively. In terms of block trades, both block deals to come to market last week hailed from the Financials sector, as First Republic Bank (\$243.3M) and PennantPark Floating Rate Capital, LTD (\$84.9M) each priced below their amended filing ranges. The largest deal of the week came in the form of a convertible offering, as Weibo Corp. raised \$900.0M, debuting out of China from the Technology sector. Of note, Weibo Corp.'s deal is the largest convertible deal to come to market out of China since 2010. The other convertible deal came from a company that priced a follow-on last week as well, as China Lodging Group, Limited raised \$425.0M with their second deal of the day. Looking ahead to this week, eight IPOs are expected to price for total proceeds of \$2.0B as the calendar turns to November. The largest expected debut of the week is from Industrials company, Loma Negra Compania Industrial Argentina S.A., which is expected to bring in \$853.4M in proceeds. Elsewhere, Evoqua Water Technologies Corp. is seeking to become the first Utilities IPO since October 2016 while generating \$500.0M in total proceeds.
