



Weekly Commentary

U.S. markets ended the week mixed as the House of Representatives passed the GOP Tax bill. The DJIA lost 0.3%, the S&P fell 0.1% and the NASDAQ increased 0.5% last week.

In energy news, crude oil futures fell 0.3%, closing the week at \$56.55 per barrel amid the news that Saudi Arabia is expected to support the extension of OPEC's deal to slow down global oil production. Natural gas lost 3.6% to close the week at \$3.10 per mmbtu as the Energy Information Administration reported an decrease in inventories of 18 billion cubic feet to 3.772 trillion cubic feet for the week ended November 10th. Analysts were expecting a decrease of 14 billion cubic feet.

In U.S. economic news, retail sales grew 0.2% in October, below the prior month's upwardly-revised 1.9% rise, but besting estimates of a 0.1% gain. Additionally, retail sales excluding automobiles grew 0.1% in October, decreasing from September's upwardly-revised 1.2% growth, and missing estimates of a 0.2% gain. Separately, PPI and Core PPI reported 0.4% increases in October, matching the prior month, and besting economists' predictions of a 0.2% and 0.1% gain, respectively. In labor news, initial claims for the week were 249K, above both the prior week's claims of 239K and estimates of 234K. Meanwhile, continuing claims reported a 1,860K reading, falling from the upwardly-revised 1,904K reading reported in the prior week. In housing news, housing starts for October were released as 1,290K, above both the prior month's upwardly-revised 1,135K and estimates of 1,198K. Elsewhere, building permits for October were reported as 1,297K, higher than September's upwardly-revised 1,225K and estimates of 1,243K. Separately, export prices excluding agriculture for October lost 0.3%, declining from the downwardly-revised 0.9% jump reported in the prior-period. Moreover, import prices excluding oil for the same month climbed 0.2%, just short of the gain of 0.3% last month. Finally, Industrial production increased 0.9% in October, rising from the upwardly-revised 0.4% increase seen in September, and besting consensus estimates a 0.5% uptick.

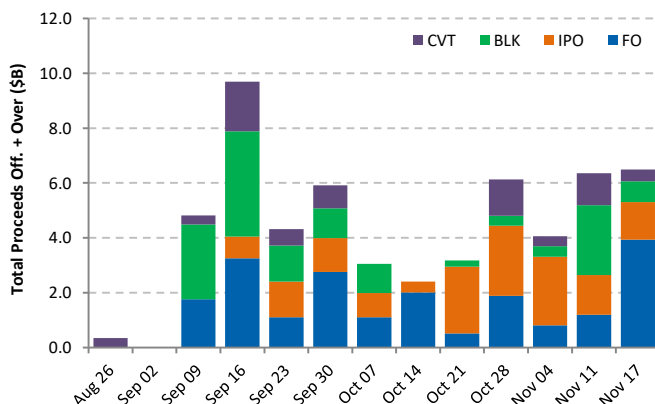
In corporate news, Tyson Foods, Home Depot, Target, and Cisco beat earnings estimates, while Aramark, Sally Beauty, and Spire missed analyst expectations. Meanwhile, Advanced Auto Parts, TJX, L Brands, Best Buy, and Viacom reported mixed results. In M&A news, Emerson Electric increased its bid to acquire Rockwell Automation to \$225 a share or a total value of \$29 billion, as Cardinal Health announced it is selling its Chinese pharmaceutical and medical-products distribution business to Shanghai Pharmaceuticals for approximately \$557 million.

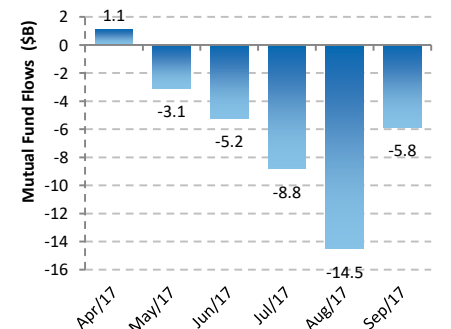

New Issuance Recap:

As Americans prepare for their Thanksgiving feasts, the new issuance market set the table last week with 34 deals (9 IPOs, 17 FOs, 5 BLKs, and 3 CVTs) for combined proceeds of \$6.5B. The largest deal of the week came in the form of a follow-on, as Alnylam Pharmaceuticals, Inc. brought in \$805.0M in total proceeds to become the sixth largest offering from the Healthcare sector year-to-date. Meanwhile, Gardner Denver Holdings, Inc. had the second largest offering of the week, which raked in \$599.5M in proceeds out of the Industrials sector. Separately, the IPO market kept its strong momentum, matching last week's deal count as Blank Check company, Legacy Acquisition Corp. raised \$300.0M. Furthermore, SailPoint Technologies, Inc. and SendGrid, Inc., marked the 23rd and 24th Technology debuts of the year while raising \$240.0M and \$131.2M, respectively. Meanwhile, Jianpu Technology Inc., of the Industrials sector, generated \$180.0M and is the second Chinese Industrials IPO to debut on a U.S. exchange this year, following BEST Inc.'s \$517.5M offering in September. Elsewhere, five Block offerings priced last week for combined \$748.1M, led by Genpact, LTD. and Third Point Reinsurance Company, Ltd. who generated \$304.5M and \$236.3M, respectively. In terms of Convertible offerings, Quotient Technology Inc. from the Consumer Services sector raised \$175.0M in total proceeds and was accompanied by Rambus Inc. (\$150.0M) and Everbridge, Inc. (\$115.0M) of the Technology Sector. Looking ahead to this week, no deals are expected to price during the Holiday shortened week.
